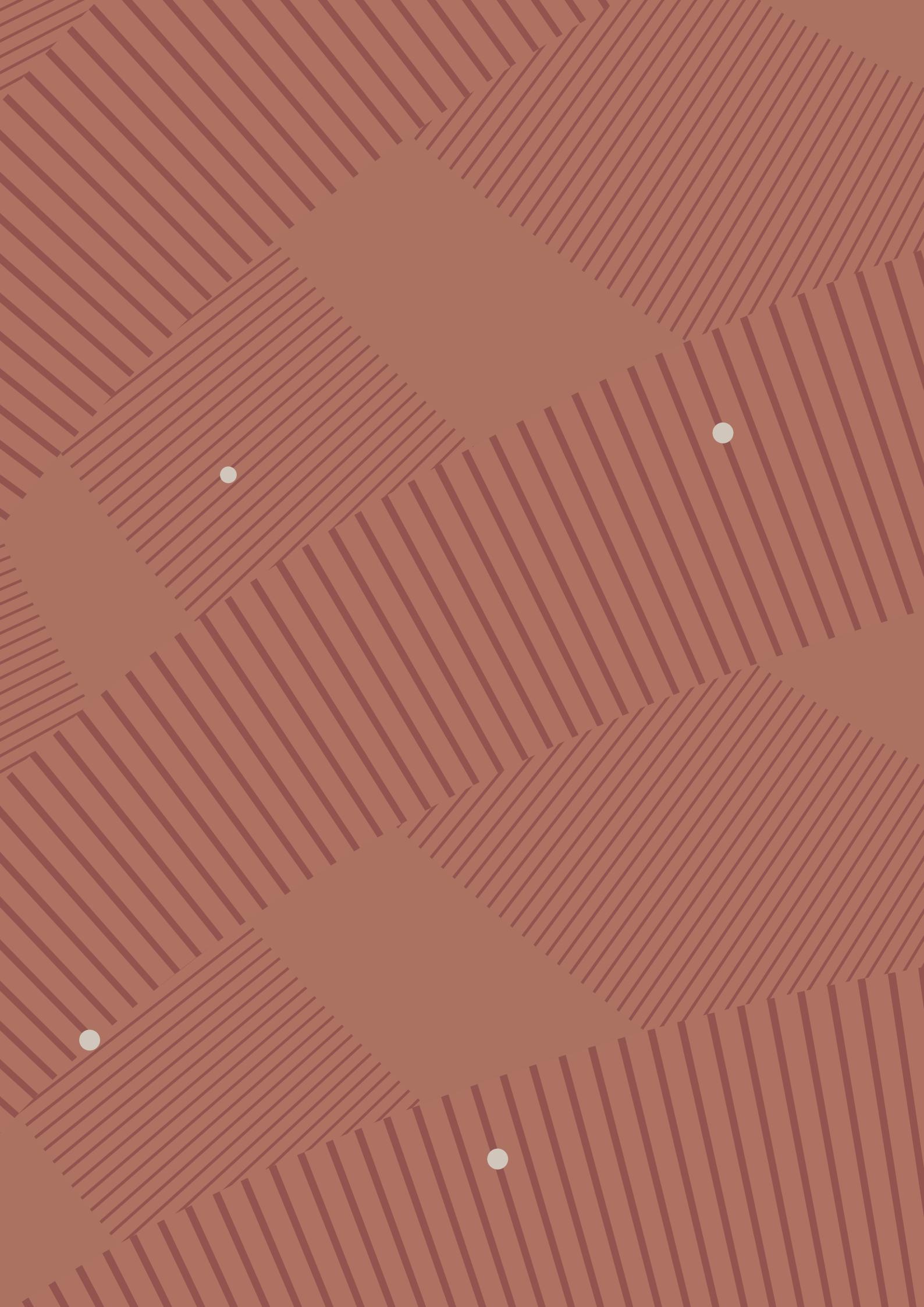

A team of approximately 50 lawyers across our offices advises on structured finance (including securitization, strategic situations finance and distressed finance), pre-insolvency restructuring, recovery strategies for stressed debt assets, insolvency and crucially, policy reforms (advising the ministries, regulators and government) in the context of each of these practices. AZB is the only Indian law firm that houses each of these connected practice areas in one team. We believe our lawyers need to develop domain across all these practices in order for them to be able to advise clients in any of them, given their inherent inter-connectedness.

The firm's compelling reputation in this space is a result of its success with managing multiple complex restructurings/insolvencies and marquee structured finance and securitisation transactions for a range of stakeholders and leading industry-defining and market practice changing mandates and establishing precedents on complex untested critical legal issues.

We have advised on almost all the market firsts in this space - we advised on India's first foreign capital investment into domestic Indian distressed debt, the country's first loan-to-own debt purchase and consequent restructuring, the first insolvency proceeding against a systemically important financial institution (and are now advising on all three of the ongoing insolvency proceedings against systemically important Indian financial institutions - DHFL, SREI and Reliance Capital), the country's first aviation insolvency resolution process, India's first credit bid and also the country's first case involving striking down of security provided to banks as an avoidable preference. We developed and continue to ideate on structures that create the market precedent for the most complex and marquee structured finance and securitization deals, some of which have set the template for structures via which foreign capital invests into the country's stressed assets.

AZB (via Bahram, our founding partner and other lawyers) played an instrumental role in the drafting of India's Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC) as well as numerous other linked financial sector regulations and reforms. The firm continues to play a role in the evolution of this area with Bahram and other partners' participation in committees set up by Indian ministries, the Indian central bank and various sectoral regulators - such as the Bankruptcy Law Reforms Committee, constituted by the Ministry of Finance, the Insolvency Law Amendment Committee, constituted by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) to recommend yearly amendments to the IBC, and many other committees of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), MCA and Insolvency & Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI).

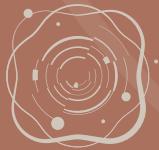

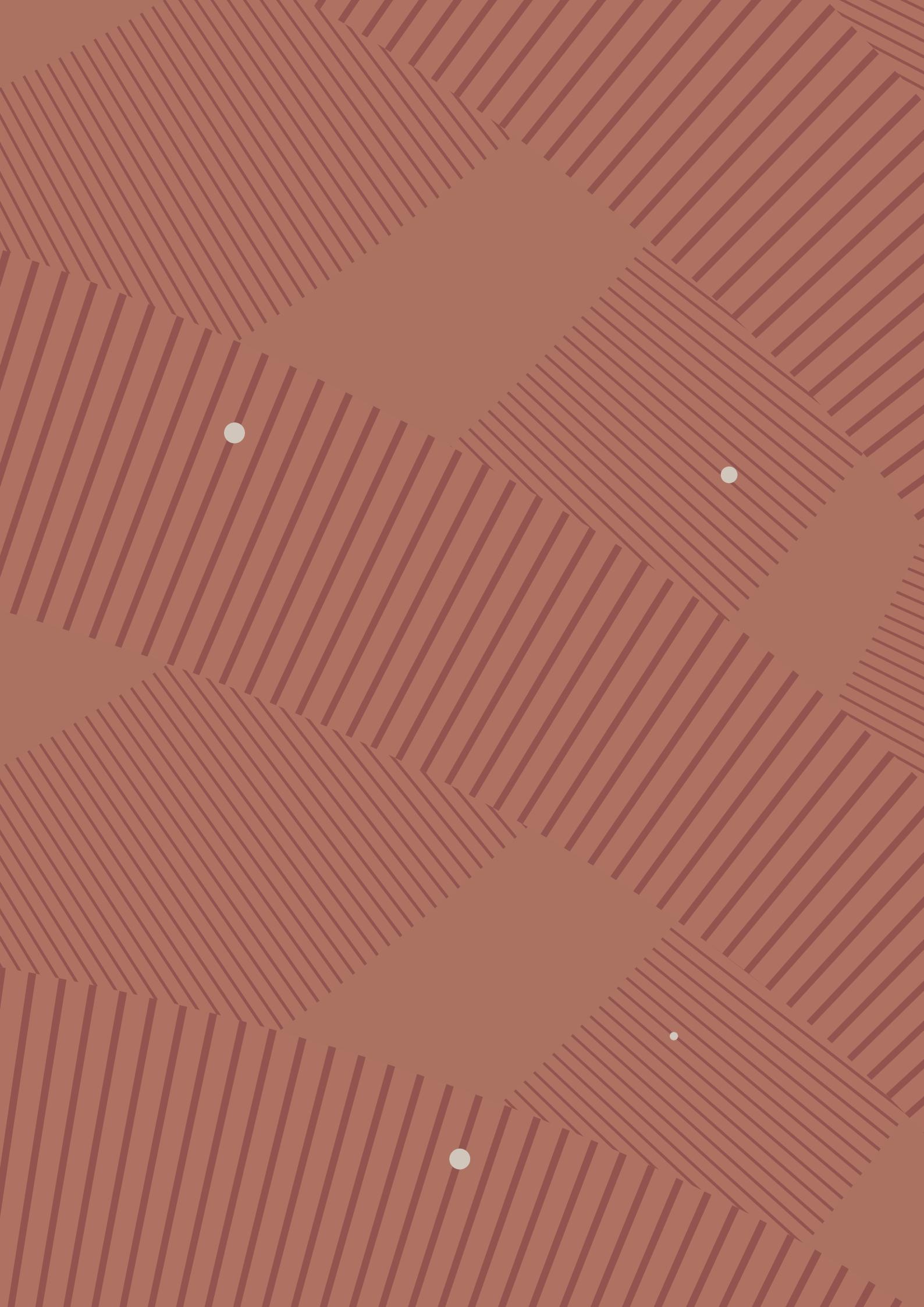
